
FACETIME SQUIRREL NUT HUNT


SQUIRREL NUT HUNT IS A GREAT WAY TO HAVE KIDS INTERACTING WITH FRIENDS DURING THIS TIME OF SOCIAL DISTANCING.
THE GAME IS THE SAME WAY WHETHER THE PLAYERS ARE IN THE SAME ROOM, ACROSS THE STREET OR IN DIFFERENT COUNTRIES.



YOUR PLAY AREA- Colour each of the rectangles at the bottom of this sheet, cut them out and place them on to the grid on this side of the game. These are your hidden nuts. (Or you can colour in the squares on the grid to show where each of your nuts are hiding. For example 5 squares in a row either vertically, horizontally or diagonally for a walnut, 3 squares for a hazelnut etc.)



YOUR SEACH AREA - One player at a time (the searcher) says the coordinates of the square they are seaching (ex. B9). The other player will tell them if they "found " or "missed" a nut. The Searcher should mark this side of their sheet with an X in the square if it was a miss and colour the square if they found part of a nut. Now it is the other player's turn. When a player has found all the squares for a nut, you say "you stole my nut". A player wins when they have stolen all of the other players nuts.
